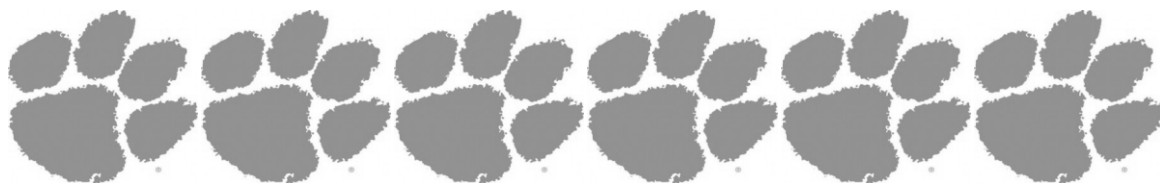
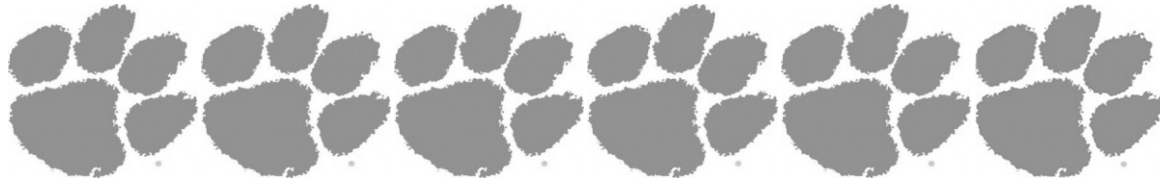

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO EACH VENDOR. ANY FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH LISTED RULES MAY RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM PREMISES ALONG WITH THE LOSS OF LEASED LOT(S) UPON MANAGEMENT'S DISCRETION.

1. Tiger Country Trade Days space receipts are issued for the sole purpose of admitting said vendor only on the grounds. All vendors must have a receipt which must be presented when renewing space(s). No sub-leasing of spaces will be allowed and identification may periodically be requested. All rentals are on a month-to-month basis.
2. Vendor receipts issued when spaces are paid each month are for the purpose of identifying vendor vehicles. One vendor receipt is required for each vehicle or trailer and must be visible when entering and while parked on vendor lots.
3. Vehicles parked illegally or on a lot not assigned to the vehicle owner will be towed at the owner's expense.
4. Management shall designate selling areas (spaces). Each vendor shall conduct business only within the confines of his/her designated space(s).
5. A vendor may be re-located if not on lot by 7:00 am. Pavilions, shops and food courts must be opened Fri & Sat.
6. No construction such as tables, racks, walls, etc., may be built on a space without management consent.
7. Food items must be sold from a concession stand that meets the States of Texas Health Department standards. The sale of any food item requires management's consent, including soda or water.
8. Management reserves the right to restrict the sale, display or distribution of any printed materials, photographs, books, paraphernalia or other representations in order to maintain a proper moral, wholesome environment. No one shall bring upon or distribute on the grounds any political, religious or solicitant matter or handbills without proper consent of management.
9. Spaces may not be used for games of skill, raffles, lotteries, palm reading or such, auctions or any purpose which is carnival related.
10. The following will not be allowed for any reason: alcoholic beverages, loud music or amplifiers, or vulgar language of any kind. Please remember this is a family oriented event and this type of disturbance will NOT be tolerated.
11. Merchandise on the grounds is done so entirely at the risk of the owner.
12. Advertisements must be displayed only from bulletin boards located throughout the grounds. No advertisements may be placed on trees, buildings, etc.
13. Vendors are responsible for the cleanup of any trash. Clean up fee assessed to vendors leaving discarded items on any area of the Pavilion. Vendors must take trash to receptacles.
14. In accordance with state law, waste water of any type may not be discharged into, or flow into a public place, gutter, street, creek, etc.
15. Vehicles or trailers remaining on the grounds after 7:00 a.m. Sunday will be charged \$10 per day. Unattended vehicles or trailers will be impounded.
16. A speed limit of 5 M.P.H. throughout the Tiger Country Trade Days grounds will be enforced.





- 17. No motorcycles, bicycles, four-wheelers, skateboards, roller-skate or golf carts are allowed to be ridden on the grounds or under the Pavilion at any time.
- 18. Renewal of spaces may be made during the show at the office for the following month. A vendor will lose their lot if not paid for by the Monday before the event, 5:00 pm. There will be no refunds for any reason without a two week notice of cancellation.
- 19. Office is open Monday-Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Please call in advance.
- 20. The office will not cash checks or accept two-party checks. Money-Orders and a Check from a local Bank will be accepted from reserved vendors when renewing or renting a space. There will be a \$45 charge on all returned checks; fund availability will be verified prior to set-up.
- 21. Parents or guardians are responsible for minor children brought onto premises. Minors must remain with parent or guardian.
- 22. Management is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged merchandise, personal property or vehicles while on premises.
- 23. Pets on premises or for sale must be kept in designated areas and in owners possession at all times.
