Horsemanship – Learning To “Think Like A Horse”

If you want a better relationship with your horse, you want your horse to be more relaxed and you want to better understand your horse, this is the clinic for you. “Knowledge of the horse is best gift you can give to your horse.”

Rick is a student of the horse. He relies on sacking out (Desensitizing/Sensitizing) to deal with spooky, abused or ex-race horses. He believes you have to teach a horse that it is alright to be scared. By approaching problems and issues from the “Horse’s” point of view you show the horse you understand them. “A bad horse is never born, they are made.”

Morning: Foundation Horsemanship Class (Understanding the horse)

The foundation Class, is sort of a 'catch all' class. It's a great way to refine and perfect your ground work. Learn the philosophy and get a better understanding of why the horse reacts the way he does. If you have a horse that needs some restarting or has some quirks and troubles...this is the class for you --- rebuild your foundation so that the horse will have a chance to understand what you want and how to give it to. Are you timid or new to horses or clinics - let this be your 'starter'-- Rick will guide you into understanding the “The way of the horse” and will provide you a better understanding of “**Natural Horsemanship**”.

Rick’s clinics are designed as a confidence builder for both you and your horse. As many of you know each clinic Rick teaches is completely different; as it is based on the students and horses in the class, everyone will learn something that will help them down the road to better understanding the horse. In these clinics students will start with groundwork, then transition to learning in the saddle. Rick is always open to helping with troubled horses.

Afternoon: Horsemanship I Class

The students gain a new understanding of their horse -- how they move, why and when to direct. This class helps horse and human gain confidence, safety and the ability to understand the horse. Remember horsemanship is easy -- get the horse to want to be with you whether you are on the ground or on his back!!!

It doesn't matter which class you attend with Rick, he is there to give you as much information as possible. So be ready to become a sponge and soak it all in! Remember - we are here to learn about the horse and become a better partner to the horse, so enjoy yourself, leave your stress and fear behind and let Rick take you on an educational, inspirational, exciting journey to real horsemanship.
